# 2022 Winning Ways with Western Dressage Rules and Guidelines

**Entries:** Entries for competing and non-competing (schooling horses) must include current AQHA registration papers, AQHA membership cards, Coggins, entry form, liability release and fees. One entry form per horse and rider combination. Entries may be registered online at [www.lynnpalm.com](http://www.lynnpalm.com) or mailed to the show manager. Open date May 1, closing date Wednesday, June 1. Entries received after the closing date may be accepted with a late fee of \$25 per horse rider combo. No refunds

**Fees:** The same horse/rider combination may enter a maximum of 3 classes per day. Fees are \$45.00 per class which includes results reporting to AQHA and WDAA. There is a \$30.00 office fee per horse/rider combination. The fee for non-competing (schooling horses) is \$25.

**Payment:** Make checks payable to **Royal Palm Ranch** and mail to: **Marie-Frances Davis 9497 NW 60<sup>th</sup> Ave Ocala, FL 34482.**

**Stabling and lodging:** All resort accommodations including ship in fees, stabling, bedding, housing, camping and golf carts must be reserved with Joyce at the Grand Oaks Resort. 352 750-5500 extension 236 [joyce@thegrandoaks.com](mailto:joyce@thegrandoaks.com)

**Schooling:** Schooling is available at The Grand Oaks Resort on Friday afternoon (12:00 pm) for horses that are registered for the show. There is no schooling in the show arena on the day of the show.

**Footing:** Covered arena 20m x 60m dressage arena.

**Awards:** Ribbons through sixth place. A high score award will be presented to the highest scoring rider of the day in each division (Open, Amateur and Youth).

**Directions to Grand Oaks Resort:** From the North (Ocala, Summerfield, Belleview) Head South on Hwy 441/27. Go past The Villages Regional Hospital. Go past the overhead bridge that says "The Villages". Turn left at Griffin Avenue. Stay on Griffin Avenue and pass through one stoplight. Take Griffin Avenue for about two miles and turn left at gated entrance. From the South: (Leesburg, Tavares, Mount Dora) Head North on Hwy 441/27. Turn left at CR 25. Stay on CR 25 and pass under the bridge and pass Post Office. First stoplight is Griffin Avenue. Turn right onto Griffin Avenue. Go for approx. two miles and turn left at gated entrance.

Correct tack and attire will be required as defined by USEF/WDAA. Please see rule book for a complete listing by discipline. [USEF WD Rules](#) [AQHA Rulebook](#) Any topics that are not specifically addressed in the above guidelines or any exceptions to the guidelines must be discussed with and approved by the show manager. Any violation of the show rules can result in your exclusion from this and future events.

Ride times will be emailed to each entrant. Classes will NOT run in order

# 2022 Winning Ways with Western Dressage Show Clinic Entry Form

On Sunday join the group for an 8:00 classroom session on the levels, geometry of the arena and basic rules for competition. After this session 8 riders have the opportunity to ride with higher accuracy. Lynn will offer tips to grow your scores through corrections in rider's position and balance, use of aids or improving horse's balance. With a conclusion at the end of the day, a dedicated time to Questions and Answers for all aspects of western dressage is your chance to collect information you need to host an event, compete, instruct, or coach.

Monday and Tuesday 8 riders will work with Lynn in 2 groups 2 sessions per day. The clinic will follow a succession to improve rider and horse at their current level or prepare for their next level.
